Series: *At The Movies*

Part 7: *End Game*

1) This week's movie was *End Game*. It's a movie about a group of superheroes who came together to defeat evil. If you could have your choice of being any superhero, who would you be and why?

2) We only have one life to live. But sometimes in the busyness of living, we forget to pause and think about life itself. The Bible teaches us to see life in a very specific way. Read James 4:14. What does this verse say about the duration of life? How have you seen this truth in the world around you?



3) The truth is *life is short*. Whether we live for 10 years or 100 years, this length is not that long in the larger context of history. Because the *duration* of our life is short, we need to consider the *direction* of our life. There is a story in the Bible about a man who didn't think about the direction of his life. Instead, he just focused on living comfortably. Read Luke 12:16-21. What was wrong with this man's thinking?

4) We only have one life to live. Consequently, we need to make it count. We can do this by *fighting for the things that matter* and *sacrificing for the people who matter*. What are the things that God is placing on your heart to fight for? Who are the people God is placing on your heart to love sacrificially?

5) End your small group time in prayer.
