Seasons of the Cross

Green: The colors of the various seasons of the Christian year express the mood or feeling of that season. Green expresses the ongoing work of God and our participation in him and in his work. Though God's work of creating is finished, his work to sustain and grow his Kingdom is not. Particularly, in this season after Pentecost, we strive to live in and through the power and presence of the Holy Spirit - praying and living so as to display and declare the glory of Jesus in all we do.

Scripture Passage and Sermon Outline

Proclamation of God's Word

Text: Acts 9:1-9, 20-22 (ESV)

Title: Encountering the Extraordinary

Teacher: Shayne Bass

¹ But Saul, still breathing threats and murder against the disciples of the Lord, went to the high priest ² and asked him for letters to the synagogues at Damascus, so that if he found any belonging to the Way, men or women, he might bring them bound to Jerusalem. ³ Now as he went on his way, he approached Damascus, and suddenly a light from heaven shone around him. ⁴ And falling to the ground he heard a voice saying to him, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?" ⁵ And he said, "Who are you, Lord?" And he said, "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting. ⁶ But rise and enter the city, and you will be told what you are to do." ⁷ The men who were traveling with him stood speechless, hearing the voice but seeing no one. ⁸ Saul rose from the ground, and although his eyes were opened, he saw nothing. So they led him by the hand and brought him into Damascus. ⁹ And for three days he was without sight, and neither ate nor drank. ²⁰ And immediately he (Saul) proclaimed Jesus in the synagogues, saying, "He is the Son of God." ²¹ And all who heard him were amazed and said, "Is not this the man who made havoc in Jerusalem of those who called upon this name? And has he not come here for this purpose, to bring them bound before the chief priests?" ²² But Saul increased all the more in strength, and confounded the Jews who lived in Damascus by proving that Jesus was the Christ.

Intro: If an extraordinary encounter for your faith life was an option, would you choose it?

Bad Breath

Saul's violent rampage emanates from so deeply within who he is, that it flows out of him like breath. How could we possibly relate?

But, But, But...

The miraculous and extraordinary thing about Saul's conversion isn't his encounter with a great light, but is rather what he hears. Can you hear it?

Barely Believable

Saul's transformation is so sudden, radical and effective that it leaves the Jews confounded. Has anyone ever been confounded by the change in your life?

YOU CAN PRAY WITH US...

1. Worship the LORD for His goodness to chase us down with His incomparable love and for graciously overcoming our brokenness. Praise Him, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit for His power to change lives.
2. Is there some part of your sin and brokenness that you have lost hope over and stopped believing in God to change in you? Is there someone in your life who is lost in sin that you are not believing in God for their conversion? Confess your unbelief to Jesus, seek His forgiveness and ask that He would grant you faith in His life changing power.
3. How has He changed you? Take an inventory of the change the Holy Spirit has worked in you and is continuing to work in you, and in those around you and give thanks.
4. Who do you know that needs to encounter God and His life changing love and grace? Pray that Jesus would meet them where they are, interrupt their lives and that they would have the spiritual eyes and ears to recognize Him as their LORD.
5. Ask the Holy Spirit to renew in you a longing to encounter Him in the light and glory of His grace, in a daily Bible reading practice and for the boldness to invite friends, family, neighbors, and co-workers into those encounters.
